**24 OVERLAND FLOW STUDY AND FLOOD PRONE LAND**

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COUNCILLOR HUTCHENCE TO MOVE

1. Council notes that a report on the process for assessing submissions to the Overland Flow Study is currently in preparation and is scheduled to be considered by Council at the May Ordinary Meeting,
